

Year 7 Literacy & Numeracy Catch-up Premium Grant



The school receives a small amount of catch-up premium grant for Year 7 Literacy & Numeracy. This ensures there are funds to provide catch-up support for any year 7 pupils who did not meet the expected standard in reading and/or mathematics at the end of key stage 2.

The funding for those pupils who need extra support from the year 7 catch-up premium has been used for individual and small-group tuition sessions as well as additional services and materials to support learning.

A guided reading session included in the timetable across primary every morning. Pupils normally read with an adult. Some more able pupils in KS1 have made great progress since September, now they read in pairs. They listen to each other and then ask questions about the book using Bloom's questioning guide. It helps to develop their comprehension but also questioning skills.

Some pupils receive additional phonics support. Two pupils in Tiger class work 1:1 with a member of staff every morning. They both need Phonics intervention.
