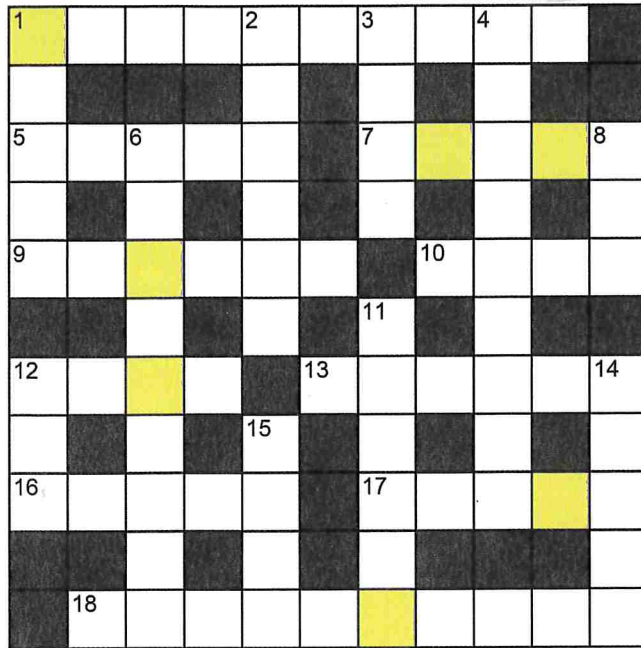

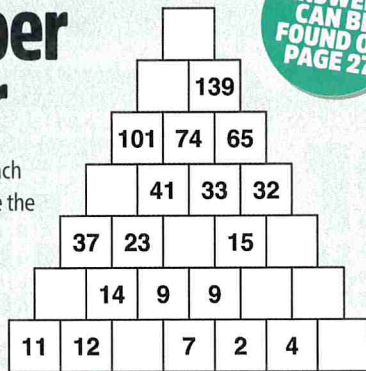


Keyword clue: Creatures

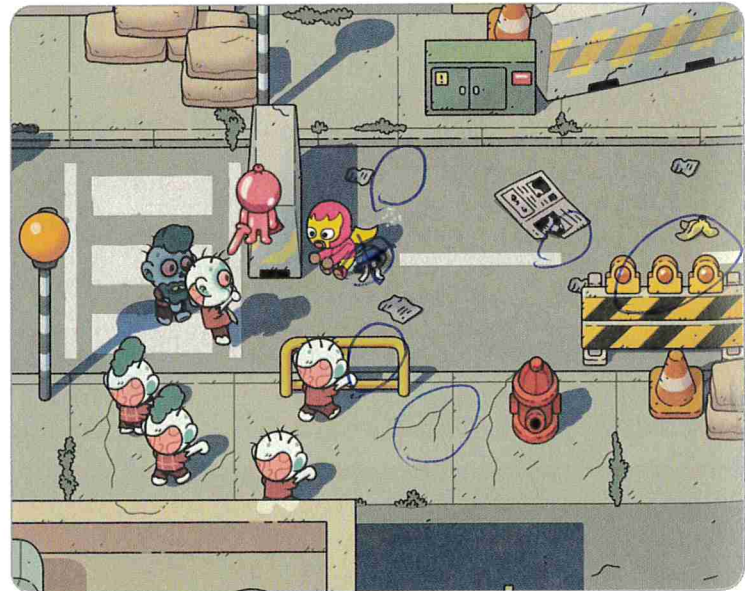

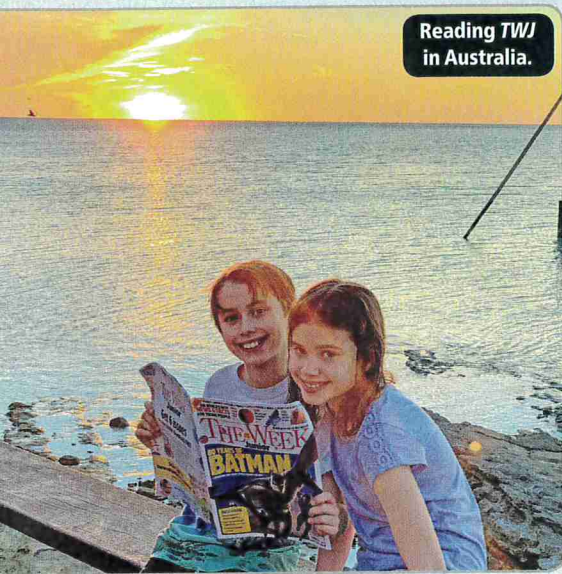
