

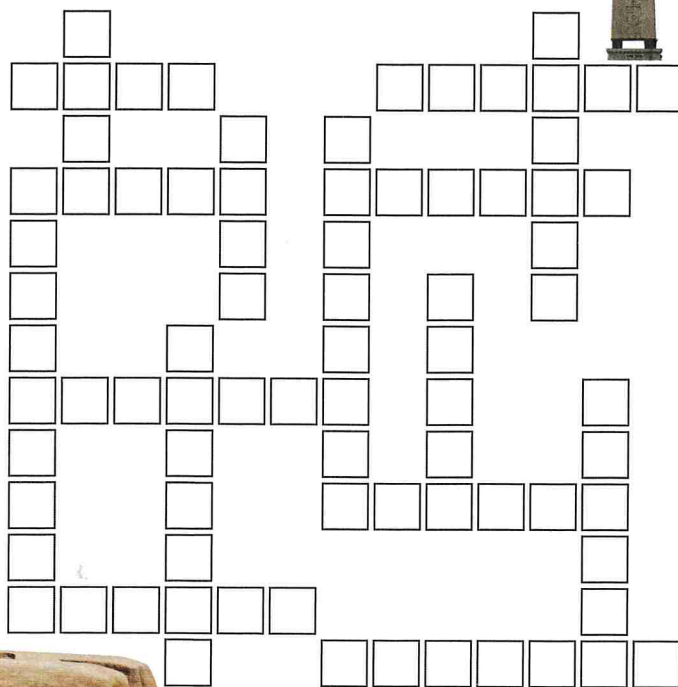

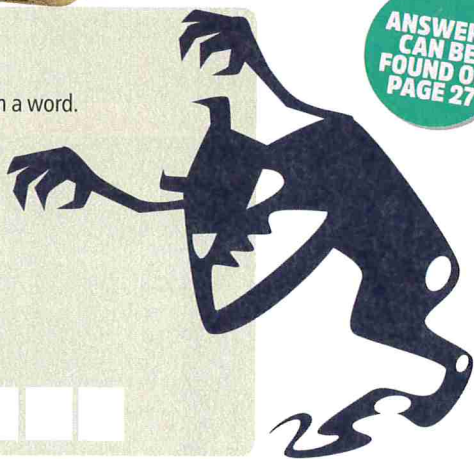

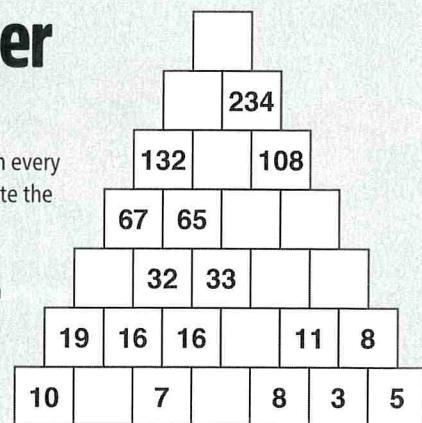

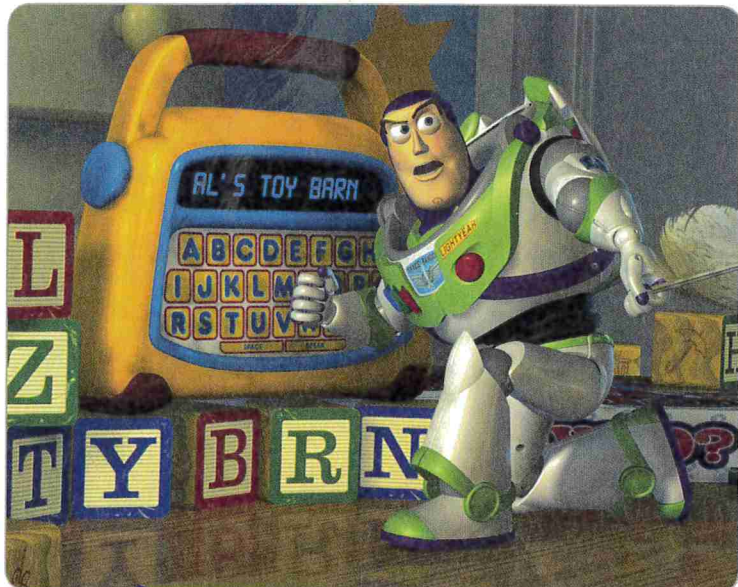
Number tower

Spot the difference

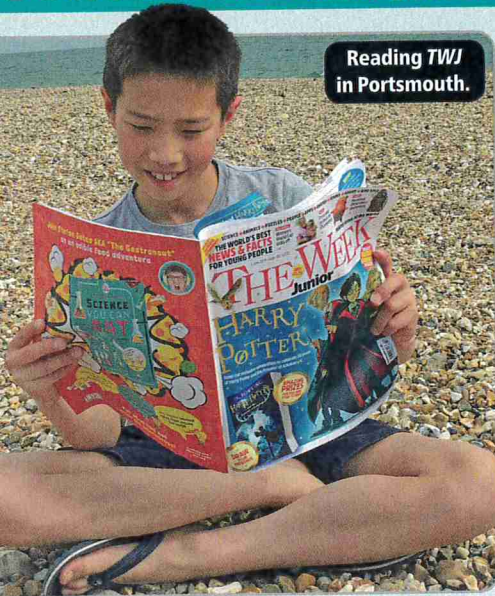
These two pictures of Buzz Lightyear from the *Toy Story* films appear to be the same, but take a closer look. There are actually five differences. Can you spot them?

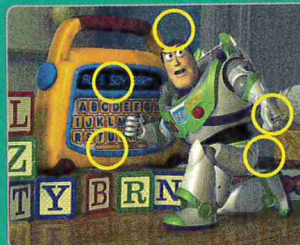
